**Venue** Stantonbury Campus Leisure Centre, Milton Keynes, MK14 6BN

**Refreshments** Snacks, light meals and drinks are available in the café from 0900-1600. Please note: it is strictly forbidden to take your own refreshments into the café.

**Entry Fees** £14 for 1 weapon  
£25 for 2 weapons  
£35 for 3 weapons  
Fencers aged 70+ may enter both Category 3 and Category 4 at no extra cost.  
Fencers aged 40-49 may enter one, two or three weapons for £14.

**Closing Dates** Entries received after 18<sup>th</sup> April may be accepted at the discretion of the organisers, at double the normal fee. Places for the dinner cannot be guaranteed after 18<sup>th</sup> April, and the accommodation deal at the hotel must be taken up by 11<sup>th</sup> April.

**Eligibility** Open only to paid up members of the NVA, by age category.  
This event will be used for selection for the 2008 World Championships.  
Therefore the qualifying date is **your age on 1<sup>st</sup> October 2008.**

**Equipment** Foil and Epée: maraging blades are required for the safety of your opponent. Such blades have the letters FIE stamped somewhere near the guard.  
Sabre: blades must comply with current standards of stiffness, and have a date stamp of 2000 or later somewhere near the guard.
