Please find attached the running order of the pistes for the Veterans Winton Cup and a reminder to order the Gala Dinner. The gala dinner is now ordered via the BVF web site, John Mason has a fantastic food order system !!

- If not pre ordered and they wont be attending the Gala Dinner.

We have some teams that have ordered no gala dinners at all-and for the vets this is hard to believe, they like their fun!! –

So we are just about all set. On the web you can view the full team list- hope you have added your team if you have not please do so asap as Frank and I are filling in gaps. There are VERY few gaps now; we will just about have a full match. So the running order becomes paramount to the smooth running of the day.

We have 9 teams, 6 teams will fence and 3 teams sit out and **referee** at each round. This means that one of your fencers from each weapon team **MUST** referee one of the ongoing matches.

Note well: penalties will be imposed if teams delay the running of the competition by not being in the right place at the right time! **BEWARE!!!**

Costs

£360 per team: £20 per fencer. Captain please arrange a single payment to John Mason.

Saturday: 7 Rounds

Arrive 8am and lay pistes (as many fencers as possible please)

CHECK IN CLOSES AT 9.30AM

Team managers please check in your WHOLE team.

Fencing starts at **10 am**.

We will not have time for an official lunch break. But you will be resting at some stage during the day so take lunch when you can.

We aim to start the last round at 4 so we can finish by 5 and are back at the hotels for dinner.

Sunday 5 Rounds

CHECK IN CLOSES AT 9.30AM

Start fencing at 10 am, fence for 5 more rounds and then end with medals and a lunch if ordered.

All clear the pistes and off for 4 or 5
